2Email

(Give pre-primary and primary learners the experience of using email without the Internet! 2Email safely simulates the email environment. By enabling them to Compose emails using words and pictures, Use word banks to support Literacy and 2Respond automatically interacts with the child, extending dialogue)

ICT skills

- Transferable skills of sending, receiving and logging into email without having to go on the Internet.
- Printing, replying and/or deleting messages.
- Typing skills are practised.
- Importing clips, using words and/or pictures to create mail and learning how to create and address book
- Attaching files

Learning areas

- Reading and viewing: LO3; Recognises and makes meaning of texts and words.
- Language structure and use: LO6; Relates sounds to letters and words
- Promotes dialogue by responding to others emails.
- Learners will be able to use a word bank to support their literacy skills.
- Sending a specific subject based email will include other subjects into this scheme of work.

Other subject areas can easily be linked into 2email. Eg.

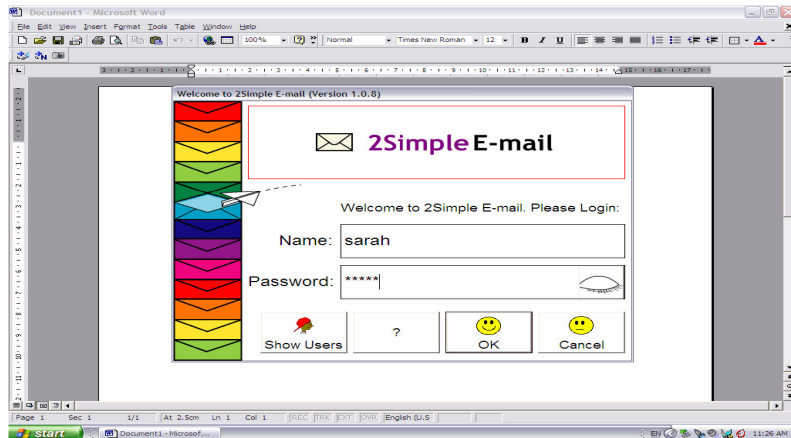
- Life orientation; Send a list of healthy food that you can buy at the supermarket

Learning Level

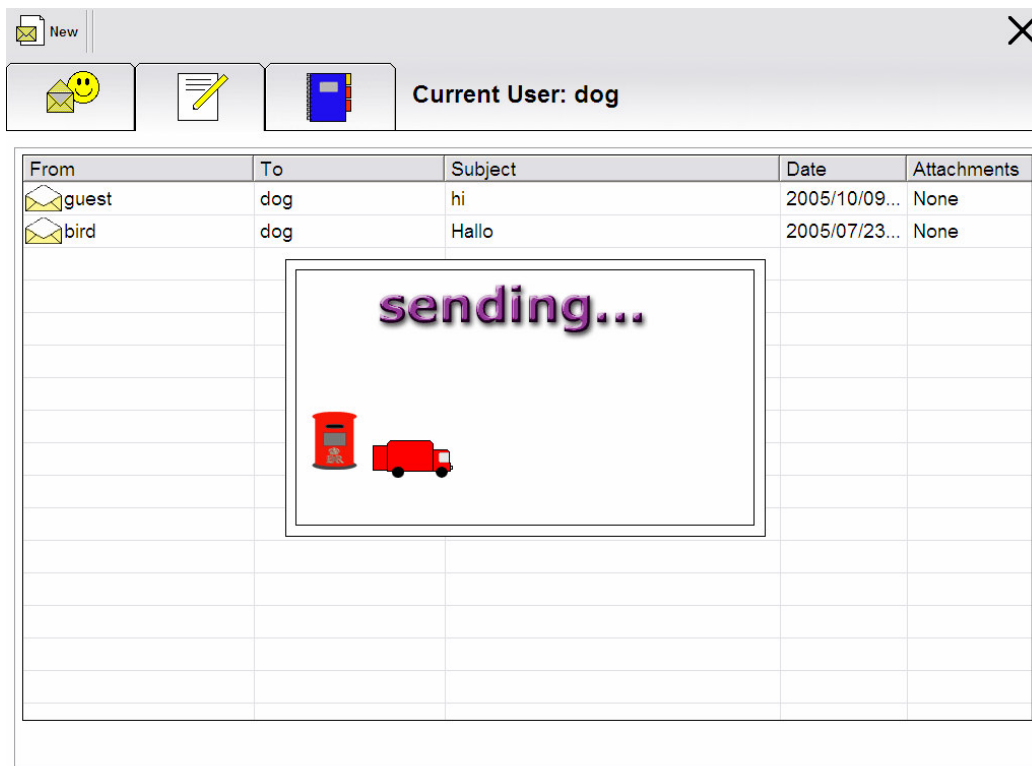
Grade 1 – 7
